


Welcome to Sevier County!

Welcome to the Sevier County Fairgrounds Multi-Use Facility! Built in 2009, this new facility has hosted a number of events including the Sevier County Fair, Southern Utah Junior Livestock Show and Auction, Demolition Derby, Outdoor and Indoor Concerts, Business Meetings, Parties, Banquets, Reunions, Horse Races, Horse Shows, Rodeos, Circus, Agriculture Conferences, 4x4 Rock Crawl Competitions, and much more!

Exhibit Hall

The Exhibit Hall has a spacious 10,354 square feet and is perfect for banquets, parties, or social events. The Exhibit Hall has a full kitchen for your catering needs. The Hall is equipped with a sound system, portable stage, tables and chairs, and three adjoining conference rooms. Seating capacity is 690.

The paved parking lot has over 275 parking spaces, with additional parking available.



Indoor & Outdoor Arena's



The 80' x 100' Indoor Arena has spectator seating capacity of 290. This building is available year round and has restrooms, office space, dressing and shower rooms, and a large lobby.



Measuring 150' x 220', the newly remodeled Outdoor Arena has plenty of space for stock and everything needed to accommodate a professional rodeo, horse shows, pleasure riding, training, or other equestrian events. A new announcers booth with sound system stands just above the bucking chutes.

Race Track



This 1/2 mile racetrack is home to the Annual Independence Day Horseraces. The track is professionally groomed during summer months and is used by many to condition and train their prized racing prospects.



Seating

There is seating for 3,000 around the Outdoor Arena and the Race Track. 1,200 of those seats are covered. Seating can be expanded to over 4,000 for large events.

Covered Stalls



The North Wing is designed for small breeds, such as hogs, sheeps and goats. There are 146 pens measuring 5' x 10', but can easily be converted to a 10' x 10' stall for 73 larger pens. Fresh water and power are available.

The South Wing is designed for large breeds, such as horses and beef. There are 55 stalls, measuring 10' x 10'. Fresh water and power available.

Long term boarding is available with 10' x 12' covered stalls, located on the South East portion of the Fairgrounds.

Stage & Picnic Area

The new Outdoor Stage is a great place to hold events such as concerts and plays! Restrooms and dressing rooms are available inside this covered, 2,330 square foot building. The platform of the stage measures 30' x 34'.




The pavilion is a popular place to hold social gatherings, dances, reunions, etc.

Where is Sevier County?


