The opening number of the competition is not scored or judged. It's simply a modeling pattern mixed with a few poses to introduce all contestants to the audience, and get our show started with a bang! All you will need is black bottoms (skirt, caprese, pants, shorts) and black or silver shoes that are easy for you to model in. We will provide a top for you to wear.

Casual Wear

Casual wear is an opportunity to show off your personality! Clothes should be something you would actually wear out with your friends, or on a fun date. Anything from a cute sundress, to caprese with a cute blouse will work, just make sure your outfit says "This is Me!"

This is your chance to wear that prom dress again! Any style of evening gown will be accepted! Most evening gowns are floor length, and gloves will be allowed if desired. This is an opportunity to feel beautiful, and show your grace and poise to the judges and audience.
